

Car Owner Responsibility Act (C.O.R.A.)

Whenever a police officer has reasonable suspicion to believe that a vehicle should be declared a "Public Nuisance", that vehicle is subject to seizure pursuant to Chapter 9 Article I, Section 9-12, Paragraphs (1) THROUGH (9) OF THE Code of Ordinances of the City of Rock Island. The following offenses have been declared a public nuisance by ordinance.

Possession of a Controlled Substance	30 day hold	\$1080.00

The vehicle owner has the right to post a Cash Bond as indicated in Section 9-16(a), 1 through 6 to retrieve possession of their vehicle pending a hearing to be held by the City's Code Hearing Officer. If your vehicle is towed, the vehicle owner will need to pick up the vehicle release form at the Rock Island Police Department located at 1212 5th Av, Rock Island, IL.
