

Testing in Rock Island for 2010 Census Positions

The U.S. Census Bureau will recruit nearly 3.8 million applicants for 2010 Census field operations. Of these applicants, the Census Bureau will hire about 1.4 million temporary employees. Some of these employees will be using GPS-equipped hand-held computers to update maps and ensure there is an accurate address list for the mailing of the census questionnaires.

The US Census Bureau will be testing on the following dates and times for upcoming 2010 Census positions:
