RE: Quad Cities Auto Auction
Assumption of Agreement with Wag's Auto Center
Re: Undercover Vehicles

On March 7, 2016, council approved a contract with Wag's Auto Center for the rental of undercover vehicles at a monthly cost per vehicle of \$400.00 to commence on April 1, 2016 and extend through midnight on December 31, 2016.

Ken Wagler, owner of Wag's Auto Center has indicated to the Chief of Police that he is going to be unable to complete the remainder of his agreement with the City regarding the Undercover Vehicles. Mr. Wagler has contacted Quad Cities Auto Auction, who has agreed to pick up Wag's agreement with the City for the remainder of the year under the same terms and conditions.

While RIPD will seek new bids for a contract going forward in 2017, an agreement is necessary for the balance of 2016 as undercover vehicles are switched out monthly.

RECOMMENDATION

That council approve Quad Cities Auto Auction taking over the terms and conditions of the present agreement with Wag's Auto Center for the rental of undercover vehicles at a monthly cost of \$400.00 per vehicle beginning on or about October 1, 2016, through December 31, 2016 and that the monthly cost will be prorated accordingly between Wag's Auto Center and Quad Cities Auto Auction depending upon the actual date Quad Cities Auto Auction takes over the agreement.
