TRAFFIC STUDY INFORMATION:

When The Locks were constructed it limited the sight distance when traveling northbound on 20th Street to 1st Avenue (IL-92). Since then this street has been temporarily turned into a one-way for southbound traffic on 20th Street between 1st and 2nd Avenue.

COST:

The cost to the city is minimal.

RECOMMENDATION:
