

A SPECIAL ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE DONATION
OF CERTAIN REAL ESTATE OWNED BY
THE CITY OF ROCK ISLAND, ILLINOIS

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROCK ISLAND, ILLINOIS:

Section One. It is hereby determined that the retention of the title to the following described real estate owned by The City of Rock Island, Illinois, is no longer necessary, appropriate, required for the use of, profitable to, or for the best interests of The City of Rock Island, Illinois:

Lot Number Ten (10) in Block Number Seven (7) of Buford and Guyers Addition to the City of Rock Island, situated in the County of Rock Island, in the State of Illinois,

commonly known as 1527 – 36th Street, Rock Island, Illinois

Section Two. That said property is a part of the list of properties approved for the 2016 H.O.M.E. Program as approved by council on August 23, 2016, and will be removed from the Program in order to complete a donation to Development Association of Rock Island (D.A.R.I.).

Section Three. The City of Rock Island, Illinois, agrees to donate the aforementioned described property to Development Association of Rock Island, an Illinois not-for-profit corporation, in exchange for accepting donation of another property owned by D.A.R.I..

Section Four. Mayor, Dennis E. Pauley, and the City Clerk be, and are hereby authorized and directed to execute on behalf of The City of Rock Island, Illinois, a Warranty Deed conveying the above-described real estate to Development Association of Rock Island.

Section Five. All ordinances and part of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed insofar as they do so conflict.

Section Six. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect 10 days from its passage and approval, as required by law.
