

A SPECIAL ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 3 AND CHAPTER 8  
OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF  
THE CITY OF ROCK ISLAND, ILLINOIS

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROCK ISLAND, ILLINOIS

Section One: Chapter 3, Section 3-11(i) of the Code of Ordinances of The City of Rock Island, Illinois, is hereby amended by deleting same in its entirety and by inserting in lieu thereof the following:

**“(i) *Gambling Devices*: No gambling device or other gambling paraphernalia shall be kept or used for the purpose of gambling in any location licensed under the provisions of this chapter; provided, however, the prohibitions provided for in this chapter and any other chapter of this code that may reference or govern gambling or gambling devices shall not preclude any activity or device permitted under the laws of the State of Illinois, so long as the device or paraphernalia complies with all requirements under the laws of the State of Illinois, and in addition thereto, complies with all requirements of this and any other ordinance of the City of Rock Island, Illinois, related to such gambling device or other gambling paraphernalia.”**

Section Two: Chapter 8, Article III, Division 2, Section 8-97 of the Code of Ordinances of The City of Rock Island, Illinois, is hereby amended by adding the following:

**“(c) No license for any video gaming terminal shall be issued to any applicant until and unless the applicant provides information to the satisfaction of the Liquor Commissioner demonstrating that the applicant’s proceeds from video gaming machines are secondary to the applicant’s combined proceeds from alcohol and food sales for the location at which the applicant is making application for a video gaming license or video gaming licenses. The final determination on whether the applicant has satisfied this requirement rests with the Liquor Commissioner. This ordinance shall only apply to new gaming licenses issued after the effective date of this ordinance. It shall not affect any licensed establishments seeking to renew gaming licenses which were acquired prior to the date of this ordinance. ”**

Section Three. All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed insofar as they do so conflict.

Section Four. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect 10 days after its passage and approval, as required by law.
