Attached is a letter from Deborah Davis on behalf of Radicle Effect Brewerks and owner Rich Nunez requesting permission to have live entertainment (bands) with sound amplification outside in their parking lot on Friday, July 14, 2017 from 7:00 to 11:00 p.m. The business is located at 1340 31st Street.

The parking lot will be fenced off with only one entrance to be manned by security at all times and accessible from the sidewalk. The parking lot will be closed off (including the handicapped spot) from 2:00 p.m. to 2:00 a.m. They have secured permission from Bowman Accounting to use their parking lot that evening.

They are also requesting approval for the consumption of alcohol outdoors in the fenced-in parking lot area during their event.

Radicle Effect Brewerks has stated they have contacted their residential and commercial neighbors regarding their plans for the event.

The certificate of insurance is on file.

RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended that Council approve the requests for live entertainment outdoors with sound amplification and the consumption of alcohol outdoors for Radicle Effect Brewerks on Friday, July 14, 2017 from 7:00 to 11:00 p.m. at 1340 31st Street, subject to complying with all liquor license regulations and subject to being closed down early if noise complaints are received.

Dear Mayor Pauley,

I'm writing today on behalf of Radicle Effect Brewerks and owner, Rich Nunez, so that we may formally address the Rock Island City Council to express our interest in holding an outdoor event on Friday, July 14th, 2017.

We would like to block off our west parking lot for the evening and bring in a stage, which we would have placed at the north end of our lot. There we would like to have live music playing, all local rock n' roll bands, from 7-11pm.

The space we will be fencing off is 26"x 51.5" and we will use rented metal fencing. We plan to have one entrance into the demarked area, manned by security at all times, accessible from the sidewalk. We plan on closing off the entire parking lot, including the handicapped spot, from 2pm - 2am. We have permission from Bowman Accounting to use their parking lot that evening, which makes up for our lost spots as well gains many more.

We have spoken with our other neighbors, both commercial and residential, and all are informed of our intentions and have given their support in us hosting such an event. This includes: Bowman Accounting, Cool Beanz Coffehouse, More Than Just Antiques, and homeowners Tara Polek and the Foxes.
