



Whitewater Junction Aquatic Center Rules & Policies

**This is not an exhaustive list of rules and policies.*

Staff reserves the right to make judgement decisions to ensure a safe environment for all patrons.

Please help us keep Whitewater Junction a safe and enjoyable facility for all by following the rules below:

1. All patrons must pay the admission fee or scan their valid membership card.
No exceptions.
2. Children under 9 years old must be accompanied by an adult or guardian 16 years old or older and has paid admission.
3. Running, jumping, and rough-housing will not be permitted.
4. Abusive and/or profane language is prohibited.
5. Patrons must stay off the lifeguard stands. Patrons may not place any items on the lifeguard stands.
6. Only U.S. Coast Guard approved personal flotation devices are allowed.
7. Inflatables intended for use as a personal flotation device are prohibited with the exception of Whitewater Junction inner tubes on the green slide and plunge pool.
8. Patrons must be 18 years old or older to use snorkels.
9. Hanging and/or playing with the safety ropes is not permitted.
10. Glass bottles of any type are not permitted.
11. Outside coolers, food, and drink is not permitted inside the facility. Patrons may leave and reenter the facility at no charge by getting a stamp from the Ticket Takers.
12. Pets or other animals are not permitted in the facility. (Exception: Service Animals with a signed Liability Release Form.)
13. Smoking and tobacco use are prohibited in the facility.
14. Public displays of affection are not permitted.
15. Gum, eating, and/or drinking is not permitted in the pool area.
16. The City of Rock Island is not responsible for lost or stolen items.
17. Diving in shallow water is not permitted.
18. Flips, twists, or turns from the side of the pool are not permitted.
19. All patrons must be facing the water when jumping into the pool.
20. Holding hands while jumping into the pool is not permitted.
21. Staff reserves the right to prohibit certain pool toys based on the safety of all patrons.
22. Aquatic staff has final authority. This includes enforcement of rules, discipline, and ejection of patrons from the facility.
