

Rock Island County State's Attorney's Victim/Witness Program

The Rock Island County State's Attorney's Office has a Victim/Witness Program with two full-time advocates. These advocates assist victims and witnesses following a violent crime. One of the advocates will serve as your liaison between law enforcement, the State's Attorney and the judicial system.

****Any suspect arrested will have a Detention Hearing within 24 or 48 hours of their First Appearance in Court. You have the right to attend this hearing and may qualify to obtain an Order of Protection.**
