

CONCRETE FLATWORK BOND

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that we _____, of the City of _____, County of _____, State of _____, as Principal and _____, as Surety are HELD AND FIRMLY BOUND unto the CITY OF ROCK ISLAND, ILLINOIS, in the penal sum of Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000), lawful money of the United States, for payment of which sum, well and truly to be made, we hereby bind ourselves, our heirs, executors, administrators, personal representatives, successors and assigns, jointly and severally, firmly by these presents.

THE CONDITION OF THE ABOVE OBLIGATION IS SUCH THAT, whereas the said _____ desires to construct concrete flatwork on City right-of-way in said City, and;

WHEREAS, Chapter 13, Article IV, entitled Sidewalks of the Rock Island City Code requires that every person, firm, or corporation engaging in the business of the construction of concrete flatwork before entering upon the construction of such concrete flatwork in or upon any public right-of-way in the City of Rock Island, shall file with the Public Works Director of the City of Rock Island, a bond in the penal sum of Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000), running to the City of Rock Island, Illinois, with sureties, to be approved by the Public Works Director, conditioned upon the obligated satisfactory performance of all duties required by the ordinance, rules or regulations established by the City Council.

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of said permit now or hereafter being granted, issued or renewed, said principal shall:

1. Suitably guard and protect any excavation or obstruction, and defend, save, keep harmless and indemnify the said City of and from all actions, suits, costs, damages, and expense whatsoever, including Attorney fees, which shall or may at anytime happen to come to if for or on account of any injuries or damages received or sustained by any party, caused by any negligence in either the execution or protection of the work being done.

2. Maintain and keep in good repair for a period of two (2) years, ensuring after the date of its acceptance by the Public Works Director of all concrete flatwork constructed under said bond.
3. Pay any penalties that may be imposed during the period of any such present and future permit.

Compliance with all and several of the above enumerated items shall make this bond void. Otherwise, it will remain in full force and effect within the City of Rock Island, Illinois. This bond shall be considered a continuous bond in the above stated amount for each periodic permit, now or hereafter issued to principal, the same as though a separate bond for each such present and future permit has been executed notwithstanding this is a continuous bond until canceled by written notice from the bonding company. The surety shall have the right to cancel this bond for future liability upon thirty (30) days written notice to the City of Rock Island.
