Attached is a letter from Junior's Tap (Dee's Place) requesting permission to hold an outdoor event in their parking lot on Saturday, July 28<sup>th</sup>, 2012 from 3:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m. at 2536 5<sup>th</sup> Avenue. Junior's Tap is also providing live music (band) for this event. The parking lot will be fenced in.

Junior's Tap will provide security personnel to ensure that minors do not enter the fenced in area. ID's will be checked for age verification and wristbands will be utilized.

Alcohol will not be sold outside. However, patrons will be allowed to carry their alcoholic beverages from inside the establishment to the fenced in area outside.

Junior's Tap has contacted the neighbors that may be affected by this event.

**RECOMMENDATION:**

It is recommended that Council approve the outside event for Junior's Tap, subject to complying with all liquor license regulations and subject to being closed down early if noise complaints are received.

As the owner of Junior's tap located at 2536 5<sup>th</sup> ave Rock Island IL I am writing to request permission to hold an outdoor event in my parking lot on Saturday July 28, 2012. This event would include live music from 3p.m. until 9pm.

My parking lot will be roped off with security personal on hand. I would be setting up tents with tables and chairs so that customers may sit outside with their drinks but no alcohol would be sold outside. I will have it set up so customers could be served through the back door of my establishment there by keeping all beverages in the area of the parking lot. We will not have any glass bottles or cups outside. I would also have personnel stationed to card and stamp everyone before they can enter.

Then at 10pm we would be closing down the outside area and no beverages would be allowed outside after that time.
