**PROCLAMATION**

**WHEREAS,** The National Alliance for Mental Illness is an organization dedicated to calling attention to the problem of mental illness across America and to the fact that one in four adults experiences a mental disorder in a given year; and

**WHEREAS,** about 2.4 million Americans, or one percent of the adult population lives with schizophrenia and 5.7 million American adults or approximately 2.6 of the adult population suffer from bi-polar disorder; and

**WHEREAS,** anxiety disorders including panic disorder, obsessive compulsive disorder, and post traumatic stress disorder affect about 18.1% of adults or estimated forty million individuals; and

**WHEREAS,** half of all life time cases of mental illness begin by age 14, with three-quarters by age 24; and

**WHEREAS,** the NAMIWALKS to be conducted on October 6, 2012 is intended to call attention to the problem of mental illness and to build support for adequately addressing the problems of the mentally ill.


**NOW, THEREFORE,** I, Dennis E. Pauley, Mayor of the City of Rock Island, proclaim Saturday, October 6, 2012 as
