

A SPECIAL ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 8,
ARTICLE VII, DIVISION 6,
OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE
CITY OF ROCK ISLAND, ILLINOIS

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROCK ISLAND, ILLINOIS:

Section One. Chapter 8, Article VII, Division 6, of the Code of Ordinances of The City of Rock Island, Illinois, is hereby amended by inserting the following:

(p) (1) Between the hours of 12:00 a.m. and 3:00 a.m., Monday through Sunday, no person between seventeen (17) and twenty (20) years of age is permitted to loiter, congregate or remain in the public areas of the Great River Plaza in the areas defined as follows: An area of the city containing outdoor pedestrian improvements which consists of the following streets and sidewalks:

- (a) The entire public right of way of Second Avenue between Seventeenth and Eighteenth Streets and Eighteenth and Nineteenth Streets.
- (b) Public sidewalks on the north and south sides of Third Avenue between Seventeenth and Nineteenth Streets.
- (c) The sidewalk on the west side of Seventeenth Street between First and Third Avenues.
- (d) Sidewalks on the east and west sides of Eighteenth Street between First and Third Avenues.
- (e) Sidewalks on the east side of Nineteenth Street between First and Third Avenues.
- (f) Arts Alley: The municipality owned property extending from the public right of way of Second Avenue between Seventeenth and Eighteenth Streets to the alley right of way between Seventeenth and Eighteenth Streets and lying between the quad city arts center and the renaissance center buildings.
- (g) The city parking facilities identified as Lot C, Lot F, and Lot G in Chapter 9, Article II, Division 4, Section 9-91 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Rock Island Illinois.

(2) Exceptions. The prohibition established in paragraph (1) above does not apply to the following:

- (a) a person between seventeen (17) and twenty (20) years of age who is lawfully going to, attending, participating in or leaving from a Permitted Plaza Activity as identified in Chapter 8, Article VII, Division 2, section 8-223 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Rock Island, Illinois, during the hours of 12:00 a.m. to 3:00 a.m., including but not limited to dining at a restaurant, café or other food service facility located in those areas identified in (1) above;

- (b) a person who is in the company of a responsible parent or legal guardian;
- (c) a person who is employed by a business located in the areas identified in (1) above;
- (d) a person going to or leaving from a residence located in the areas identified in (1) above;
- (e) a person actively engaged in the maintenance of the areas identified in (1) above.
- (f) a person who is a designated driver who is waiting for his riders.
- (g) a person of the age designated above who is outdoors smoking and who meets the definition of exceptions (a-f) of this paragraph.

(3) A violation of this section is subject to the violator being fined from Seventy-Five Dollars (\$75.00) up to Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) per violation

Section Two. All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed insofar as they do so conflict.

Section Three. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval, as required by law.
