The Engineering Division solicited qualifications from consulting firms to provide field inspection services/pavement management system updates of the city's pavement network.

The request for proposals invitation was posted on the city website and advertised in the Rock Island Argus on January 29 and 30, 2013. The Engineering Division received submittals from the following consultants:

Atkins North America, Inc.	All About Pavements, Inc. (API)
Applied Pavement Technology, Inc.	Resource International, Inc.
Engineering & Research Int'l, Inc.	Ament Design
Shive-Hattery, Inc.	

The selection committee consisting of the City Engineer, two Assistant City Engineers, and the Technical Services Manager/Street Maintenance Superintendent reviewed the proposals. Based upon review of the firm's qualifications and resources, Engineering and Research International, Inc. (ERI) was selected by the committee to recommend to City Council for contract negotiations. The top three scoring firms are listed below:

- 1) Engineering & Research Int'l, Inc. (ERI)
- 2) Resource International, Inc.
- 3) All About Pavements, Inc.

Recommendation

The Public Works Department recommends that the City Council approve the choice of Engineering & Research Int'l, Inc. (ERI) and authorize the Engineering Division to enter into negotiations with them for a service agreement.

After negotiations are completed with Engineering & Research Int'l, Inc. (ERI), the service agreement will be submitted to City Council for final approval.
