The Public Works Department would like mower 9066 reinstated in the City fleet. With the wet spring and the rate that grass has been growing it has been very difficult to keep up with the mowing operation. The Waste Water Plant has been using Municipal Services backup riding mower a 1996 Snapper. Waste Water has requested we purchase a riding mower for the plant. A new mower would cost about \$4,500.00. The mower scheduled for auction on June 25<sup>th</sup> would only sell for around \$1,500.00 and would be in our best interest to assign the Snapper to Waste Water and the John Deere to Municipal Services as a backup mower.
