All alcohol will be served from the bar area inside the restaurant. However, patrons will be allowed to carry their alcoholic beverages from inside the establishment to the deck area outside. ID’s will be checked for age verification.

It is noted that amplified sound (music) will be provided by a live band. Mr. Bergheger has stated that the neighbors that may be affected by the sound amplification will be notified.

The certificate of insurance is on file.

RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended that Council approve the outside event for Jake O’s Grille, subject to complying with all liquor license regulations and subject to being closed down early if noise complaints are received.
