WHEREAS, former United States Representative Lane Evans was first elected to the 17th Congressional District seat on November 3rd, 1982 and represented the Quad-Cities in Congress for 24 years. During his tenure, Representative Evans worked to retain Rock Island Arsenal jobs, assist veterans and move the Quad Cities forward in countless ways; and

WHEREAS, there is a growing movement to name, or rename a street in the Quad Cities area for former Representative Evans; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Evans' legacy of tireless service to the people of the Quad-Cities should be honored with a street bearing his name; and

WHEREAS, for many years during his career, Representative Evans lived at 1516 37th Street, Rock Island.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Rock Island, State of Illinois, that 37th Street in Rock Island, from 12th to 18th Avenues, be ceremoniously named "Lane Evans Drive" and that the appropriate signage indicating this designation be added to the signage currently in that area.
