

RESOLUTION TO PROHIBIT COMMERCIAL MINING OPERATIONS WITHIN THE CITY OF ROCK ISLAND KNOWN AS JUMERS CROSSING

WHEREAS, on March 18, 2013 the City of Rock Island, Illinois purchased from RiverStone Group, Inc. eight (8) parcels of real estate located on that part of Rock Island County commonly known as Big Island some of which real estate was located in the City of Rock Island, Illinois and some of which real estate was located outside of the City in Rock Island County, Illinois; and

WHEREAS, on June 16, 2013 the City of Rock Island, Illinois annexed into the City of Rock Island, Illinois tax parcel No. 11143 located on that part of Rock Island County known as Big Island; and

WHEREAS, after said purchase and annexation of the real estate from RiverStone Group Inc. that part of the City shall be now be known as Jumer's Crossing; and

WHEREAS, historically the land now known as Jumer's Crossing was owned and occupied by RiverStone Group Inc and that RiverStone Group Inc. desired to conduct sand and gravel mining operations on the property now known as Jumer's Crossing; and

WHEREAS, the residents of Big Island and the Village of Milan have expressed concerns that sand and gravel mining operations conducted on Big Island could pose a risk to the Big Island Levee; therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED, this ____ day of September, 2013 by the City Council of the City of Rock Island, Illinois that in recognition of the above, there will not be allowed or permitted any commercial sand and/or gravel mining operations to be conducted in the area of the City of Rock Island, Illinois located on Big Island and known as Jumer's Crossing.
