

A SPECIAL ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 10
OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF
THE CITY OF ROCK ISLAND, ILLINOIS

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROCK ISLAND, ILLINOIS:

Section One: Chapter 10, Article I, Section 10-9, Paragraph (d) of the Code of Ordinances of The City of Rock Island, Illinois, is hereby amended as follows:

Paragraph (d)(ii): Delete \$25.00 and substitute therefore \$50.00.

Paragraph (d)(iii): Delete said paragraph in its entirety and insert in lieu thereof the following:

(iii) The number of locations or “sites” for deer hunting to be permitted shall be set by the City Council on an annual basis. For the 2014-2015 hunting season (October 1, 2014 through January 18, 2015), there shall be fourteen (14) permitted “sites” with no more than eight (8) “sites” located on private property. The size of each “site”, whether on public or private property, must have a minimum of three (3) contiguous acres. City Staff shall identify and approve all “sites”.

Section Two. All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed insofar as they do so conflict.

Section Three. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval, as required by law.
