The Public Works Department/ Fleet Services Division requested bids for the purchase of new fuel tank monitoring systems for the Marina and Fleet Services. The new equipment will replace the 1981 INCON TS1000 system currently being used to monitor the underground fuel storage tanks at both locations. Bids were opened on March 7th and a summary follows:
