




City of Rock Island Residential Parking Permits



There are two (2) types of **Residential Parking Permit** areas:

(1) **Type A Area**—The resident or residents of a dwelling unit which abuts or is adjacent to a designated residential parking only area may obtain from the Finance Department of the City, by payment of a five dollar (\$5.00) fee, a parking permit for each owned, leased, rented or assigned vehicle. This permit will allow parking adjacent to applicant's residence only without restriction. These permits shall not be transferable to other vehicles.

Each resident issued a parking permit will also receive without additional fee two (2) visitor parking permits which may be displayed only upon vehicles not registered to residents of the dwelling and may be transferred between vehicles. Visitor parking permits may be displayed only on vehicles used by persons not at the home of the resident to whom the permit was issued, and parking it limited to that area which abuts or is adjacent to the resident's property only.

In the event that a resident does not own any vehicles, two (2) visitor permits may be obtained by payment of a five dollar (\$5.00) fee.

(2) **Type B Area**—The resident or residents of a dwelling unit which abuts or is adjacent to a designated residential parking only area may obtain from the Finance Department of the City, by payment of a five dollar

(\$5.00) fee, a parking permit for each owned, leased, rented or assigned vehicle. This permit will allow parking without time restriction in any otherwise legal parking space within the designated area. These (3) permits shall not be transferable to other vehicles.

Each resident issued a parking permit will also receive without additional fee two (2) visitor parking permits which may be displayed only upon vehicles not registered to residents of the dwelling and may be transferred between vehicles. Visitor parking permits may be displayed only on vehicles used by persons not at the home of the resident to whom the permit was issued.

In the event that a resident does not own any vehicles, two (2) visitor permits may be obtained by payment of a five dollar (\$5.00) fee.

Displaying a Parking Permit

All vehicles parking in a permit lot or other permit location are required to display an appropriate permit which shall be contained in a clear vinyl case and affixed to the lower left corner of the rear window of the vehicle.

Applying for a Residential Permit Parking Area

The minimum size for a residential permit parking area shall be the lesser of ten (10) contiguous parcels of property or lots or one complete block unless otherwise approved by the City Council.

Residents that would like residential parking will need to submit a petition that must be signed by residents representing two-thirds (2/3) of the dwelling units in the proposed area stating that they agree with having residential parking on the entire street. Residents will need to print their name and address on the petition. The petition must also indicate which type of residential parking the residents would like to have installed (Type A or Type B). Type A allows residents to park only in front of their own home and Type B allows residents to park anywhere within the residential parking zone.

The petition will need to be mailed to the City of Rock Island, Public Works Department, Traffic Engineering Committee, 1309 Mill Street, Rock Island, IL 61201.

Once the Committee receives the petition the Committee will review the petition and make a recommendation to the City Council. A copy of the recommendation and a letter stating the date of the City Council meeting will be mailed to the residents in the effected area.
