The Public Works Department/Fleet Services Division is scheduled to purchase a Truck Mounted Asphalt Spray Patching Machine this budget year. The Department staff has discussed and agreed on the type of machine and options needed to replace the 2004 Wildcat patcher currently being used by the department in the pothole patching operation. The City of Moline just purchased a new Rosco Spray Patcher on the National Joint Power Alliance (NJPA) contract, which we are also a member. The NJPA contract is \$4,000.00 less than the dealer price. Moline stated that they had minimal problems with their old Rosco machine, which made the decision to purchase a new Rosco patcher much easier.

Recommendation

The Public Works Department recommends City Council authorize the NJPA Contract purchase of a 2015 Rosco Asphalt Spray Patching Machine from Roland Machine Company Inc. in the amount of \$205,162.50. It is also recommended that an ordinance be drafted declaring the 2004 Wildcat Roadpatcher as surplus and permission given to dispose of in a manner that will be advantageous to the City.


