NATURE OF REQUEST:

The Traffic Engineering Committee received a request from Rev. Allen J. Shuler, Jr., Pastor, Olivet Baptist Church, to allow parking on 12th Street between 20th and 21st Avenues all day on Sundays, Wednesdays between 6 p.m. and 8 p.m., and during special events.

CONTACTS WITH RESIDENTS:

A letter was sent to residents on 12th Street between 20th and 21st Avenues asking for their input. Three (3) responses supported the request and none (0) opposed.

TRAFFIC STUDY INFORMATION:

Ordinance #082-2014 was passed on December 1, 2014, designating the west side of 12th Street between 20th and 21st Avenues a residential permit parking area (Type B).

Parking is banned on the east side of 12th Street between 20th to 21st Avenues.

COST:

The cost to the city is minimal.

RECOMMENDATION:

The Traffic Engineering Committee recommends that the City Council approve the request and direct the City Attorney to prepare the necessary paperwork.





Dear Mr. Thomas,

During the month of December a Residential Parking (Type B) was granted at the request of Ms. Majori Kehoe. The Type B parking is to be installed on 12th street between 20th to 21st avenues in the city of Rock Island. The Olivet Baptist Church is located at 1115 21st Avenue Rock Island, IL. We have conducted worship services at the above mentioned address for well over 30 years.

We have approximately 150-200 parishioners that gather to worship each Sunday. Due to the lack of adequate parking between 20th and 21th Avenues, we are requesting approval for a waiver permit from the City of Rock Island that will allow us {the parishioners of Olivet Baptist Church} access parking on 12th Street between 20th and 21st Avenues during the following days and time: all day on Sundays; Wednesdays between the hours of 6:00pm-8:00 pm; and during special events, such as: weddings, funerals, revivals, conference workshops and other community and religious events.

In cooperation with our neighbors, we agree to give at least a 72-hour notice to the residents on 12th Street between 20th and 21st Avenues and the City Manager whenever a special event is scheduled at Olivet Baptist Church.
