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City Council approved an ordinance at the August 24, 2015 meeting to donate several properties to GROWTH to implement the Blight Reduction Program. It has come to staff's attention that one of those properties, 1625 7<sup>th</sup> Street, has already had the structure demolished, making it ineligible to receive BRP funding. Staff would like to request City Council approve an amended ordinance removing 1625 7<sup>th</sup> Street from the list of properties to be donated to GROWTH.

AN AMENDMENT TO A SPECIAL ORDINANCE  
PREVIOUSLY APPROVED AND PASSED  
BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROCK ISLAND, ILLINOIS  
PROVIDING FOR THE DONATION OF CERTAIN  
REAL ESTATE OWNED BY THE CITY OF ROCK ISLAND, ILLINOIS

WHEREAS, a Special Ordinance was approved and passed by the City Council for the donation of certain parcels of real estate in the City of Rock Island, Illinois, to Rock Island Economic Growth (GROWTH) on August 24, 2015, and;

WHEREAS, a parcel of real estate was inadvertently listed in said Special Ordinance that is not being donated to Rock Island Economic Growth.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROCK ISLAND, ILLINOIS

Section One: The above Special Ordinance previously approved shall be amended to remove the donation of property listed in paragraph 1. of said Ordinance and legally described as:

Lot 10 in Block 4 of J.B. WINTER'S NINTH STREET ADDITION to the City of Rock Island, Township of Rock Island, County of Rock Island, State of Illinois.

Commonly known as 1625 – 7<sup>th</sup> Street, Rock Island, Illinois)

Section Two: All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed insofar as they do so conflict.

Section Three: This ordinance shall be in full force and effect 10 days from its passage and approval, as required by law.
