

A SPECIAL ORDINANCE TO ALLOW USE OF A PUBLIC RIGHT-OF-WAY
FOR A SIGN AT 4121 – 18TH AVENUE,
IN THE CITY OF ROCK ISLAND, ILLINOIS

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROCK ISLAND, ILLINOIS:

Section One. A special ordinance to allow for the use of a public right-of-way for a sign at Poor Boys Pizza and Pub at 4121 – 18th Avenue in the City of Rock Island, Illinois, be and is hereby granted with the following stipulations and conditions:

1. The internally-lit signs shall utilize the existing pole in its current location, which shall not be moved, replaced or relocated within the public right-of-way.
2. The business identification sign shall not exceed 24 square feet in area and the digital message board shall not exceed 32 square feet in area.
3. There shall be at least 10 feet of clearance between the sidewalk/pavement and the bottom of the sign and the overall height shall not exceed 20 feet.
4. The configuration of the sign cabinets shall be installed as presented to City Council at its February 8, 2016 meeting, referred to as “Option #2” in photographic representation.
5. The signs shall be set on an automatic timer and the digital message board shall include a programmable dimmer function to lessen the impact of the signs on the adjacent residential neighborhood during non-business hours.
6. Proof of liability insurance in the amount of \$1,000,000 with The City of Rock Island, Illinois, listed as an additional insured shall be provided to the City prior to the installation of the signage. The property owner shall provide the City with a copy of the annual renewal of said liability insurance policy. The liability policy shall provide that a 30-day written notice be provided to the City in the event of change or cancellation of the insurance policy.
7. A sign permit shall be obtained from the City’s Inspections Division prior to the commencement of the installation of any signage at the site.
8. The signs shall meet all other applicable codes and ordinances.

Section Two. All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed insofar as they do so conflict.

Section Three. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect 10 days from its passage and approval, as required by law.
