Subject: Icons Martini – Event with Entertainment & Alcohol
Date: April 4, 2016

Attached are three letters from Dave Phillips of Icons Martini located at 124 18th Street. Mr. Phillips is requesting permission to utilize the vacant space at 1725 2nd Avenue (formerly Mama Compton's) for a fundraising event on Sunday April 24, 2016 from 1:00 pm to 5:00 pm. It is noted that Mr. Phillips has been granted permission from the landlord to use this space.

Also attached is a letter requesting permission for an extension to their Limited Entertainment option for one day only on Sunday, April 24, 2016. Currently, Icons Martini has entertainment only on Friday and Saturday nights. The entertainment portion of the event (music) will be provided by a Band. The entertainment will be held inside. However, Mr. Phillips is also requesting for the entertainment to possibly be held outside if the weather permits.

In addition, Mr. Phillips is requesting permission for patrons to be allowed to carry their alcoholic beverages from inside the establishment to the fenced-in area outside between the former Mama Compton's (1725 2nd Avenue) and Quad City Arts (1715 2nd Avenue). It is noted that all alcohol sales will be inside the establishment and ID's will be checked for age verification to ensure that minors do not enter the fenced-in area outside.

The purpose of this event is to help defray the ongoing medical expenses for Robbie Harris.

The certificate of insurance is on file. Mayor Dennis E. Pauley has approved the letters.

RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended that Council approve the requests for utilizing 1725 2nd Avenue, entertainment (inside/outside) and outdoor alcohol for Icons Martini, subject to complying with all liquor license regulations and subject to being closed down early if noise complaints are received.
