Attached is a letter from Cool Beanz Coffeehouse and Radicle Effect Brewerks requesting permission to have outdoor entertainment on Saturday, June 4, 2016 from 1:00 pm to 5:00 pm in conjunction with the annual Retro Rally event to be held on the same day.

The parking lots along with a portion of the alley located only between Cool Beanz at 1325 30<sup>th</sup> Street and Radicle Effect Brewerks at 1340 31<sup>st</sup> Street will be used for this event. They are requesting for that portion of the alley to be closed. Eight foot metal barricades will enclose the area. It is noted that the alley will be accessible from 12<sup>th</sup> Avenue for local traffic. Sidewalks along 14th Avenue will remain open.

Cool Beanz and Radicle Effect Brewerks are also requesting permission to sell alcohol outside in the enclosed area until 5:00 pm. Cool Beanz and Radicle Effect Brewerks have stated that ID's will be checked for age verification and wristbands will be utilized in regards to the alcohol component. They are also requesting that the Public Works Department provide two outdoor trash receptacles in the enclosed area.

Cool Beanz and Radicle Effect Brewerks have stated that the neighbors that may be affected by the partial alley closing and sound amplification will be contacted.

The certificates of insurance for Cool Beanz and Radicle Effect Brewerks are forthcoming.

**RECOMMENDATION:**

It is recommended that Council approve the outdoor entertainment for Cool Beanz and Radicle Effect Brewerks, the request for the partial alley closing, permission to sell alcohol outside until 5:00 pm and authorize Public Works to provide two trash receptacles, subject to providing the proper fencing, allowing sidewalks to remain open, complying with all liquor license regulations and subject to being closed down early if noise complaints are received.

To the Rock Island Liquor Commissioner and City Council:

Radicle Effect Brewerks and Cool Beanz Coffeehouse would like permission to have outdoor entertainment June 4th between 1pm and 5pm. This entertainment will be in conjunction with the Retro Rally event in College Hill. We have reserved a band, to play from 1-3pm and would be hosting a pinup contest on the stage from 3-4pm. Before and after these events we will be playing music from the 50's, 60's and 70's from our sound system. This will subside at the end of the event at 5pm.

We also request to sell alcohol outside in this enclosed area. All patrons will have to show identification as well as be given a wrist band to show they are over 21 years old.

The event will be held in the parking lots and ally between Cool Beanz and Radicle Effect. The ally will need to be blocked off with road-closed signs from Public Works. The entire area will be enclosed with metal 8 foot barricades, as we had for events and in years previous. The entrance will have a staff member checking all over 21 year old patrons with alcohol for a wristband. We ask that under 21 year olds are allowed in the event, but all patrons over 21 will wear a wristband and IDed for drinks when purchasing. There will be a stage for the band and tent in the enclosed area. The alcohol sold and served outside will be in plastic and cans only. We request for public works to provide 2 outdoor trash receptacles in this space. The barricaded outdoor area will be taken down at the end of the event.
