The Public Works Department has been contacted by Mechanical Jobbers Marketing, Inc. in regards to extending their contract for the 2016 Manhole Lining Program. On this maintenance project, the work performed by Mechanical Jobbers Marketing, Inc. was of high quality and at favorable unit prices.

Engineering typically sees a yearly increase in labor costs of at least 3% and material costs of 2% for our maintenance programs. This anticipated rise in labor and construction material prices would likely increase the programs' unit prices over last year.

The program was funded for approximately \$52,000 in 2015. The 2016 program is currently funded by the following utility fund amount:

- Cured-In-Place Lining (Manholes – Job 2571 Phase 2) \$64,000.00

Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Council extend the 2015 Manhole Lining Program contract with Mechanical Jobbers Marketing, Inc., Lithonia GA, in order to perform the required manhole lining through 2016.
