Butch Motzer- Butch is a state licensed plumbing inspector for the State of Illinois, since 1973. Butch worked in the trade until he went to work for the City of East Moline in 1993. Butch has been the City of East Moline's plumbing inspector and recently retired in 2016. Butch was responsible for all plumbing and mechanical inspections, as well as an absent fill in for building and electrical. Butch was responsible for helping citizens and contractors both in the field and the office, enforcement of permits and codes while on and off the job. Butch also worked to enforce property maintenance violations and appeared in court to present cases.
