

A SPECIAL ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE DRILLING  
OF POTABLE WATER WELLS WITHIN  
THE CITY OF ROCK ISLAND, ILLINOIS

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROCK ISLAND, ILLINOIS:

Section One. A special ordinance is hereby established prohibiting the drilling of potable water wells within the area of the city bounded by 18<sup>th</sup> Avenue to the Alley between 18<sup>th</sup> Avenue and 19<sup>th</sup> Avenue and 17<sup>th</sup> Street to a distance of 280 feet east of 17<sup>th</sup> Street, as shown on the attached map.

Section Two. All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed insofar as they do so conflict.

Section Three. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval, as required by law.


