Attached is a letter from Junior's Tap (Dee's Place) requesting permission to hold an outdoor event in their parking lot on Saturday, July 30, 2011 from 3:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m. at 2536 5th Avenue. Junior's Tap is also providing live music (band) for this event. The parking lot will be fenced in.

Junior's Tap will provide security personnel to ensure that minors do not enter the fenced in area. ID's will be checked for age verification and wristbands will be utilized.

Alcohol will not be sold outside. However, patrons will be allowed to carry their alcoholic beverages from inside the establishment to the fenced in area outside.

Junior's Tap has contacted the neighbors that may be affected by this event.

RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended that Council approve the outside event for Junior's Tap, subject to complying with all liquor license regulations and subject to being closed down early if noise complaints are received.
