Attached is a letter from Martinis on the Rock requesting permission to hold a fundraising event outside on Sunday, August 7, 2011 from 1:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. at 4619 34th Street. Martinis on the Rock is also providing live music (band) for this fundraising event along with a number of other activities.

The event will be held on the fenced in patio. No alcohol will be sold outside. However, patrons will be allowed to carry their alcoholic beverages from inside the establishment to the fenced in area outside. Minors will not be allowed in the fenced in area.

This event is being held to help defray the cost of medical expenses for Laurie Mueeting.

Also attached is a letter to Martinis on the Rock from Mayor Dennis E. Pauley/Liquor Commissioner granting authorization for an extension to their Limited Entertainment option for one day only on Sunday, August 7, 2011.

RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended that Council approve the outdoor fundraising event for Martinis on the Rock, subject to complying with all liquor license regulations and subject to being closed down early if noise complaints are received.



Ms. Fenner:

This letter confirms that as of July 14th, 2011, Martini's on the Rock will be authorized to have live outdoor music on the patio on Sunday, August 7th from 1:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m.

This would be subject to the conditions that the live entertainment be conducted only between these hours on this date and that it would be conducted at such a level so as not to cause disruption to any adjoining property owners. Live entertainment could be shut down in the event that there are any complaints about disturbances to neighboring properties. It should be noted that Martini's on the Rock does have "limited entertainment" on their current liquor license for Friday and Saturday nights only and that this request is to have entertainment on a Sunday on a one time basis.
