The event will be held on the fenced in patio. No alcohol will be sold outside. However, patrons will be allowed to carry their alcoholic beverages from inside the establishment to the fenced in area outside. Minors will not be allowed in the fenced in area.

This event is being held to help defray the cost of medical expenses for Dick Hough.

Also attached is a letter to Martinis on the Rock from Mayor Dennis E. Pauley/Liquor Commissioner granting authorization for an extension to their Limited Entertainment option for one day only on Sunday, September 18, 2011.

**RECOMMENDATION:**






Ms. Fenner:

This letter confirms that as of August 25<sup>th</sup>, 2011, Martini's on the Rock will be authorized to have live outdoor music on the patio on Sunday, September 18<sup>th</sup> from 1:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m.

This would be subject to the conditions that the live entertainment be conducted only between these hours on this date and that it would be conducted at such a level so as not to cause disruption to any adjoining property owners. Live entertainment could be shut down in the event that there are any complaints about disturbances to neighboring properties.

It should be noted that Martini's on the Rock does have "limited entertainment" on their current liquor license for Friday and Saturday nights only and that this request is to have entertainment on a Sunday on a one time basis. Subsequent requests may result in having to upgrade your liquor license to "unlimited entertainment".
