

A SPECIAL ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE SALE  
OF CERTAIN REAL ESTATE OWNED BY THE  
CITY OF ROCK ISLAND, ILLINOIS

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROCK ISLAND, ILLINOIS:

Section One. It is hereby determined that the retention of the title to the following real estate owned by the City of Rock Island, Illinois, is no longer necessary, appropriate, required for the use of, profitable to, or for the best interests of the City of Rock Island, Illinois:

The East Thirty (30) feet of Lot Number Seven (7) and the West Thirty (30) feet of the East Sixty (60) feet of Lot Number Seven (7) in Block Number Eight (8) in that part of the City of Rock Island known as the Old or Original Town, situated in the County of Rock Island and State of Illinois.

More commonly known as: 1023 – 3<sup>rd</sup> Avenue, Rock Island, Illinois.

Section Two. The City of Rock Island has received an offer to purchase said real estate for the sum of One Thousand Two Hundred and No/100ths Dollars (\$1,200.00), for the aforementioned described property from John and Katherine Viren, and it is hereby determined that said purchase price is fair and equitable between the parties and it is in the best interest that said real estate be sold for said purchase price.

Section Three. Mayor, Dennis E. Pauley, and City Clerk, Aleisha Patchin, be and are hereby authorized and directed to execute on behalf of The City of Rock Island, Illinois, a Quit Claim Deed conveying the above-described real estate to John Viren and Katherine Viren.

Section Four. All ordinances and part of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed insofar as they do so conflict.

Section Five. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval, as required by law.
