

ORDINANCE CHANGES  
WITH ADOPTION OF 2009 INTERNATIONAL FIRE CODE

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 6 OF  
THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF  
THE CITY OF ROCK ISLAND, ILLINOIS

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROCK ISLAND, ILLINOIS:

Section One: That Sec. 6-16 of Chapter 6, Article II, of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Rock Island is hereby amended by deleting said section in its entirety and by inserting in lieu thereof the following:

**Sec. 6-16. Fire Prevention Code Adopted:**

**There is hereby adopted by the city for the purpose of prescribing regulations governing conditions hazardous to life and property from fire or explosion that certain code known as the *International Fire Code*, being particularly the 2009 edition, with its appendices, in its entirety, with its amendments which are made a part hereof by reference, and the same is hereby adopted and incorporated as fully as if set out at length herein; and from the date on which this article shall take effect, the provision thereof shall be controlling within the limits of the city.**

Section Two: That Sec. 6-19(a) of Chapter 6, Article II, of the Code of Ordinances is hereby amended by deleting “The international fire code, 2003 edition,” and by inserting in lieu thereof, *The International Fire Code, 2009 edition*.

Section Three: That Sec. 6-20 of Chapter 6, Article II, of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Rock Island is hereby amended by deleting said section in its entirety and by inserting in lieu thereof the following:

**Sec. 6-20. Establishment of Limits in Which Storage of Flammable or Combustible Liquids in Outside Aboveground Tanks Prohibited:**

- (a) **The limits referred to in section 3404.2.9.6 of the International Fire Code, 2009 edition, in which storage of flammable or combustible liquids in outside, aboveground tanks is prohibited are hereby established as follows: “everywhere within the corporate limits of The City of Rock Island, Illinois.”**
- (b) **The limits in which new bulk plants for flammable or combustible liquids are prohibited are hereby established as follows: “must comply with The City of Rock Island, Illinois, Zoning Ordinance.”**

Section Four: That Sec. 6-21 of Chapter 6, Article II, of the Code of Ordinances is hereby amended by deleting “the international fire code, 2003 edition,” and by inserting in lieu thereof, *the International Fire Code, 2009 edition*.

Section Five: That Sec. 6-22 of Chapter 6, Article II, of the Code of Ordinances is hereby amended by deleting “the international fire code, 2003 edition,” and by inserting in lieu thereof, *the International Fire Code, 2009 edition*.

Section Six: All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed insofar as they do so conflict.

Section Seven: This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval, as required by law.
