SUBJECT: Reroof Towers / Fire Station #2

The three roof towers at Fire Station # 2 are in need of repair. These slate shingles are the existing shingles from when the station was built almost 40 years ago. Several slate shingles are missing and some have slid down onto the new library roof, causing water damage to the front entrance and community room of the Library. This will correct the water issue the Library is experiencing when it rains. This has been an ongoing problem for the last 3-4 years.

Proposals have been received from three commercial roofing contractors for the reroofing of the three towers at fire station # 2 with a 50 year synthetic slate shingle.
