Subject: Bi-State Motorcycle Awareness Ride

Attached is an application, route map and two (2) letters for the Bi-State Motorcycle Awareness Ride to be held on Saturday, May 5, 2012 from approximately 1:30 pm to 2:30 pm (Approximate time using Rock Island Streets and Centennial Bridge area). The route begins at the Rock Island County Fairgrounds in East Moline, Illinois and ends at West High School in Davenport, Iowa.

Also attached is a Resolution for temporary closure of Highway 67 (15th Street) from the Rock Island, Illinois side of the Centennial Bridge and Highway 92 West (North-one lane) to 4th Street, from 1st Street, Moline, Illinois to 15th Street Rock Island, Illinois.

The purpose of the ride is to raise awareness of motorcycle riders as well as to make the riders aware of the rules and regulations for driving/riding motorcycles. The proceeds of the ride go to the Children's Therapy Center of the Quad Cities to support its therapy programs for local children. The certificate of insurance is also attached.

The Bi-State Motorcycle Awareness Council will be working with Lt. Tim McCloud regarding traffic control.





The Children's Therapy Center of the Quad Cities is proud to have served as a supporting sponsor of the Bi-State Motorcycle Awareness Ride for over 20 years. We agree with the Council's philosophy of rider and public education.

The Awareness Ride serves as a kickoff to the riding season. The goals of this ride are to educate riders on the "rules of the road" by reminding them that they have not been out riding for awhile and to make the public aware that motorcycles are amongst them once again. The Bi-State Motorcycle Awareness Council also supports both the Illinois Motorcycle Rider Education Program and the Iowa Motorcycle Rider Education Program.


The Children's Therapy Center of the Quad Cities receives the proceeds from the ride, around \$1,500.00 each year, to support therapy programs for local children. Therefore, we ask the City of Rock Island to partner with us and support this public safety project by providing a police escort and intersection support for the ride.

Together we can make the roads safer for all people and help Quad City area children at the same time.

This past year, the Children's Therapy Center of the Quad Cities provided 16,014 units of speech, physical, occupational and feeding therapy to local children. This represents a 92% increase over the past 10 years. **46% of these services were not reimbursed.** Events, like this ride, help to guarantee that no child is ever turned away because of the family's inability to pay for the services needed and provided.

RESOLUTION NO. 06-2012

HIGHWAY RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the Bi-State Motorcycle Awareness Council is sponsoring a Motorcycle Parade in the CITY of ROCK ISLAND which event constitutes a public purpose;

WHEREAS, this Motorcycle Parade will require the temporary closure of Highway 67 (15th Street), a State Highway in the **CITY of ROCK ISLAND** from the Rock Island, Illinois side of the Centennial Bridge AND Highway 92 West (North - one lane) to 4th Street, a State Highway in the **CITY of ROCK ISLAND** from 1st Street, Moline TO 15th Street, Rock Island.

WHEREAS, Section 4-408 of the Illinois Highway Code authorizes the Department of Transportation to issue permits to local authorities to temporarily close portions of State Highways for such public purposes;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the CITY COUNCIL of the CITY of ROCK ISLAND that permission to close off Highway 67 (15th Street), a State Highway in the **CITY of ROCK ISLAND** from the Rock Island, Illinois side of the Centennial Bridge AND Highway 92 West (North - one lane) to 4th Street, a State Highway in the **CITY of ROCK ISLAND** from 1st Street, Moline TO 15th Street, Rock Island as above designated, be requested of the Department of Transportation.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this closure shall occur during the approximate time period between the hours of 1:30 p.m. and 2:30 p.m. on Saturday, May 5, 2012.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this closure is for the public purpose of use for the Motorcycle Parade.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that traffic from that closed portion of highway shall be detoured over routes with an all-weather surface that can accept the anticipated traffic, which will be maintained to the satisfaction of the Department and which is conspicuously marked for the benefit of traffic diverted from the State Highway. (The parking of vehicles shall be prohibited on the detour routes to allow an

uninterrupted flow of two-way traffic.) * The detour route shall be as follows: No Detour Needed.

*To be used when appropriate.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Bi-State Motorcycle Awareness Council assumes full responsibility for the direction, protection, and regulation of the traffic during the time the detour is in effect.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that police officers or authorized flaggers shall, at the expense of the Bi-State Motorcycle Awareness Council, be positioned at each end of the closed section and at other points (such as intersections) as may be necessary to assist in directing traffic through the detour.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that police officers, flaggers, and officials shall permit emergency vehicles in emergency situations to pass through the closed area as swiftly as is safe for all concerned.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that all debris shall be removed by the Bi-State Motorcycle Awareness Council prior to re-opening the State Highway.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that such signs, flags, barricades, etc., shall be used by the Bi-State Motorcycle Awareness Council as may be approved by the Illinois Department of Transportation. These items shall be provided by the Bi-State Motorcycle Awareness Council.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the closure and detour shall be marked according to the Illinois Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that an occasional break shall be made in the procession so that traffic may pass through. In any event adequate provisions will be made for traffic on intersecting highways pursuant to conditions noted above. (Note: This paragraph is applicable when the Resolution pertains to a parade or when no detour is required.)

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Bi-State Motorcycle Awareness Council hereby agrees to assume all liabilities and pay all claims for any damage which shall be occasioned by the closing described above.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Bi-State Motorcycle Awareness Council shall provide a comprehensive general liability insurance policy or an additional insured endorsement in the amount of **\$100,000 per person and \$500,000 aggregate** which has the Illinois Department of Transportation and its officials, employees, and agents as insured and which protects them from all claims arising from the requested road closing.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this Resolution be forwarded to the Department of Transportation to serve as a formal request for the permission sought in this Resolution and to operate as part of the conditions of said permission.
