**SUBJECT:** Revenue Ordinance Adjustments per 2012-2013 Budget **Date:** 03/14/2012

---

The budget ordinance for 2012/2013 includes raising certain fees as detailed below. The City Attorney has drafted amendments to the effected ordinances as attached. Here is a summary of these ordinance changes:

1. Increase various city ordinance fines (per attached spreadsheet).
2. Increase Rental Housing Inspection Fees to include an additional \$1 per month per unit. This would apply to all units that are currently accessed rental fees.
3. Increase the refuse service charge by \$2 per month from \$2 to \$4 per month.
4. Increase Downtown Parking Permit from \$20 to \$25
5. Implement \$5 credit card handling fee for parking ticket payments processed over the phone.

**Recommendation:**

Consider, suspend the rules and pass the ordinances modifying rates per 2012/2013 budget

A SPECIAL ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 4  
OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE  
CITY OF ROCK ISLAND, ILLINOIS

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROCK ISLAND, ILLINOIS:

Section One. Chapter 4, Article VIII, Section 4-183 of the Code of Ordinances of The City of Rock Island, Illinois, is hereby amended by deleting said section in its entirety and by inserting in lieu thereof the following:

**Section 4-183. Fees:**

The following fees shall be assessed for license and inspection of rental residential property subject to this section:

Compliance inspection: No charge for first; Fifty-Five Dollars (\$55.00) per visit thereafter.

Initial inspection: Sixteen Dollars (\$16.00) per dwelling unit/rooming unit.

Renewal inspection: Sixteen Dollars (\$16.00) per dwelling unit/rooming unit.

Rental residential property license (4 or less buildings on the property): Thirty-Five Dollars (\$35.00) per year, plus an additional Twelve Dollars (\$12.00) per unit per year.

Rental residential property license (5 or more buildings on the property): One Hundred Ten Dollars (\$110.00) per year, plus an additional Twelve Dollars (\$12.00) per unit per year.

Temporary rental residential property license (4 or less buildings on the property): Thirty-Five Dollars (\$35.00) per year, plus an additional Twelve Dollars (\$12.00) per unit per year.

Temporary rental residential property license (5 or more buildings on the property): One Hundred Ten Dollars (\$110.00) per year, plus an additional Twelve Dollars (\$12.00) per unit per year.

Section Two. All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed insofar as they do so conflict.

Section Three. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval, as required by law.

A SPECIAL ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 9  
OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE  
CITY OF ROCK ISLAND, ILLINOIS

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROCK ISLAND, ILLINOIS:

Section One. Chapter 9, Division 1., Article II, Section 9-26 of the Code of Ordinances of The City of Rock Island, Illinois, is hereby amended by inserting an additional paragraph at the end as follows:

All fines for parking violations may be paid by credit card by calling the Finance Department for The City of Rock Island, Illinois. An additional \$5.00 processing fee will be charged for this service.

Section Two. That Chapter 9, Division 4., Article II, Section 9-93, of the Code of Ordinances of The City of Rock Island, Illinois, is hereby amended by deleting subparagraph (1) in its entirety and by inserting in lieu thereof the following:

(1) Downtown parking permits \$25.00 per month

Section Three. All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed insofar as they do so conflict.

Section Four. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval, as required by law.

A SPECIAL ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 13  
OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE  
CITY OF ROCK ISLAND, ILLINOIS

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROCK ISLAND, ILLINOIS:

Section One. Chapter 13, Article II, Section 13-25 of the Code of Ordinances of The City of Rock Island, Illinois, is hereby amended by deleting said section in its entirety and by inserting in lieu thereof the following:

**Section 13-25. Collection; Removal Generally:**

The Public Works Department shall provide solid waste collection and disposal services to residential properties in Rock Island with four (4) or fewer dwelling units as described in the residential solid waste disposal rules. The refuse charge shall be Four Dollars (\$4.00) per month per dwelling unit.

Residential properties with more than four (4) dwelling units may elect to receive solid waste and disposal services from the Public Works Department or make alternate arrangements. If the services provided by the Public Works Department are used, the refuse charge shall be Four Dollars (\$4.00) per month, per dwelling unit.

Section Two. All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed insofar as they do so conflict.

Section Three. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval, as required by law.
