Colleen Vollman

Mrs. Vollman has a B.A. in Anthropology/Art History from Northern Illinois University and has completed course work toward an MA in Public History at the University of Illinois at Springfield.

She has worked in the field of Historic Preservation since 1992, including experience in the fields of historic archaeology and architectural history. She was employed with the National Park Service, performing historic preservation duties, and has worked for a state historic preservation office (not Illinois), preserving the most significant sites in the state. Until recently she operated her own cultural resource management business for eleven years and in that time performed architectural surveys and determinations of eligibility, National Register nominations, and undertook federal level HABS/HAER documents.

After her husband was transferred to the Quad Cities, she became employed by the City of Moline. They purchased the Second Empire Plummer House in the Broadway Historic District, and are currently restoring the home, which was identified as one of Rock Island's 100 Most Significant Unprotected Structures in 2009.
