
# Remove Residential Parking - 500 Block of 23rd Street

Dear Mr. Hawes,

It has come to our attention that a letter to you from the residents of 23<sup>rd</sup> Street requesting removal of the permit parking will allow you to start the process with the City to have these signs removed. The original request to add parking was made by residents who no longer live here. Additionally, by allowing street parking at all times and to all people, it eliminates the need for the People's Missionary Baptist Church to install any parking lots in Broadway National Historic District. The neighborhood has had several meetings already with City staff and the church to work towards a solution to allow street parking and prevent parking lots from being constructed. We would request that the City remove this permit parking as soon as possible in hopes of first, saving residents and church goers the hassle of finding parking and second, preventing parking lots from being constructed in Broadway National Historic District.
